CURRICULUM & GOALS



Kindergarten

Our Kindergarten students will learn tefilot through songs. They will learn the Bringing It Home curriculum which will teach them about daily mitzvot ie. tzedakah, mezuzah, brachot. As well as Jewish holidays, the weekly Parsha and the Aleph Bet through hands-on activities, crafts and games. The Kindergarten curriculum is designed to generate a positive change in children by encouraging them to integrate Torah and mitzvot into their lives.

The Kindergarten students will master the names of the the Aleph Bet letters and sounds.

1st Grade

Our 1st Grade students will learn more advanced tefilot through songs. They will learn the Super Jew curriculum which introduces key Jewish concepts, mitzvot and middot. In addition, they will learn the weekly Parsha. They will learn how to relate the knowledge to their lives while instilling the idea that the Torah is our guide and source for how to live as Jews. They will be introduced to the nekudot (vowels) and begin learning to read Hebrew.

The 1st Grade students will master the nekudot.



CURRICULUM & GOALS



2nd Grade

Our 2nd Grade students will complete the entire sing-along siddur. The students will learn the curriculum of Entering the Land and will relive the journey of the Jewish people from the time the Jews entered the land of Israel. The children will gain the passion and knowledge to live according to our heritage by internalizing the lessons and skills they learnt. Our 2nd Grade will be introduced to the Aleph Champion Program, based on the martial arts motivational philosophy of color-coded levels and testing. The 2nd Grade students will master reading two to three letter words in Hebrew.

3rd Grade

Our 3rd Grade students will learn tefilot from the higher level siddur. The students will be learning the weekly Parsha and will be introduced to the international JewQ Program where students will learn Torah, play games, win prizes and compete with children worldwide. The curriculum will cover section one and two in the JewQ book- Brachot and Prayer. 3rd Grade will continue in the Aleph Champion Program, based on the martial arts motivational philosophy of color-coded levels and testing. The 3rd Grade students will master reading four to five letter words in Hebrew.



CURRICULUM & GOALS



4th Grade

Our 4th Grade students will learn prayers from the higher level siddur. The students will be learning the weekly Parsha and continuing the JewQ Program where students will learn Torah, play games, win prizes and compete with children worldwide. The curriculum will cover section three and four in the JewQ book- 12 Pesukim (12 Torah passages that summarize the essence of Judaism) and Mitzvot. 4th Grade will continue in the Aleph Champion Program, based on the martial arts motivational philosophy of color-coded levels and testing. The 4th Grade students will master reading from a siddur, the Torah and will be able to lead Jewish rituals such as kiddush, hamotzi, havdallah etc.

5rd Grade

Our 5th Grade students will continue to learn prayers from the higher level siddur. The students will be learning the weekly Parsha and continuing the JewQ Program where students will learn Torah, play games, win prizes and compete with children worldwide. The curriculum will cover section five in the JewQ book-Jewish Holidays/Months. 5th Grade will continue in the Aleph Champion Program, based on the martial arts motivational philosophy of color-coded levels and testing. The 5th Grade students will master reading Hebrew fluently.
