## **DROP OFF AND PICK UP:**

Please ensure your child arrives on time, as camp activities (including trips and swimming) may begin shortly after arrival.

Security: A security guard is on-site daily from 8:45 AM – 3:45 PM.

### Early Care:

- Located at Chai Tots Preschool
- Children ages 5+ will be transported by bus to Lanier James
- Please notify us the day before if you plan to use early care
- \$10 per use if not pre-enrolled

### After Care:

- Located at Chai Tots Preschool
  - Campers will be transported by bus from Lanier James
  - \$15 per use if not pre-enrolled

## Transportation:

### **Hollywood Bus (JZ Bistro)**

- Arrival: 8:30 AM (bus departs promptly at 8:40 AM)
- Afternoon pick-up: 3:50 PM (2:50 PM on Fridays)
- \$15 per week, per child
- Available for children ages 5 and up

### **Chai Tots ↔ Lanier James Shuttle**

- Morning drop-off: 8:50 AM (bus departs at 8:55 AM)
- Afternoon pick-up: 3:30–3:45 PM
- \$15 per week, per child

## Carpool Procedures:

### **Morning Drop-Off**

- Carpool operates from 8:45–9:05 AM
- Staff will greet your child and escort them to their classroom
- If arriving after 9:05 AM, please park and walk your child inside
- Please do not use your phone during carpool
- Remain in your vehicle at all times

### **Afternoon Pick-Up**

- 3:30–3:45 PM (Friday: 2:30–2:45 PM)
  - Children will be brought to your car
  - Late pick-up will result in automatic aftercare charges

## Swimming:

Swimming will take place at local aquatic facilities.

### Requirements:

- Camp swim shirt (required) Available for purchase.
- Arrive wearing bathing suit and water shoes
- Bring: towel, change of clothes, and sneakers

## Trips:

- Scheduled by division (refer to calendar)
- Send a water bottle and holder on trip days
- Please be sure to have any necessary waivers signed in advance.

## Camp Shirts:

- Must be worn daily (not only on trip days)
  - Available for purchase prior to camp

Includes:

- Morning snack: fruit, muffins, cereal
- Afternoon snack: fruit and dry snacks (crackers, pretzels, granola bars, etc.)
